

# A CHORUS LINE

*A Chorus Line* is a musical about dancers auditioning for spots on a chorus line. The book was authored by James Kirkwood, Jr. And Nicholas Dante, lyrics were written by Edwards Kleban and music was composed by Marvin Hamlisch.

With nineteen main characters, it is set on the bare stage of a Broadway theatre during an audition for a musical.

The original Broadway production, directed and choreographed by Michael Bennett was a critical hit in 1975, receiving 9 Tony Awards and the 1976 Pulitzer Prize for Drama. The show has enjoyed many successful productions worldwide and was revived on Broadway in 2006.
